Only animals with original registration papers, delayed certification transfer or ownership form (dated within 90 days of the show), or progeny verification forms will be allowed to show. No papers required for wethers.

Arrival/Check-in: Friday, May 21st after 3:00 or Saturday, May 22nd from 8:00 to 8:45.

Do not bring animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, visible sores, lice, diarrhea, etc.) Health checks will be done by club members.

Entry Fees: \$7 per animal. Entries postmarked after May 14th, will be \$10.00 per animal which includes a late fee of \$3.00. There is a \$1.00 per class credit for PPGC club members. Only changes within classes will be accepted without the late fee. Payment in full must be sent with entry. Please return entries on original form. Do not make your own form. Copies of the form are acceptable. Sign and return with full payment.

Pens: Pens are available at \$7.00 ea. The pen size is 8' x 6' they are really big, and PENS ARE LIMITED. There will be straw available. If at all possible, we are asking you to clean your pen after the show on Sunday or when you leave. There will a \$10.00 cleaning fee that is refundable if you clean your pens. This is per pen.

Show Schedule: Show time is 9:00 starting with showmanship, wethers, does & bucks with master champion classes after each buck & doe show. Both buck shows are on Saturday.

Turn RIGHT onto NW BUCKLIN HILL RD. Turn RIGHT onto NELS NELSON RD NW. Turn RIGHT onto NW FAIRGROUNDS RD (map above shows this route)OR Turn RIGHT onto NW BUCKLIN HILL RD. Turn RIGHT onto TRACYTON BLVD NW. Turn LEFT onto NW FAIRGROUNDS RD.
