No papers required for wethers.

Arrival/Check In: Goats must arrive between 6-9 am. On Friday the 24<sup>th</sup>, and Depart on Sunday between 6-8 pm. on Sunday the 26<sup>th</sup>. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Showtimes – Friday 24<sup>th</sup>(Fair Show) at 2:00 pm, CPGA shows will start at 10 a.m. Saturday and Sunday.

**PENS ARE VERY LIMITED - We would prefer two bucks per pen and at least 4 does per pen.**

Health Check: Do not bring animals with obvious signs of illness (runny nose, visible sores, lice, diarrhea, etc). Health checks to be performed by CPGA members as well as fair veterinary. No refunds for failed Vet Checks. Scrapie ID Required.

Entry Fees: \$7.00 per animal. **CPGA members receive \$1.00 per entry discount.**

**Entries postmarked after August 20th** will be \$9.00 per animal which includes a late fee of \$3.00. Only changes within classes will be accepted without the late fee. There will be NO refunds given for any reason unless severe hardship. Payment in full must be sent with entry. Please return entries on original form. Do not make your own form. Copies of the form are acceptable. Sign and return with full payment.
